



**Villages Honor Flight, Inc.
Policy B-05
Policy for Non-traditional Missions**

Article 1: Purpose.

The purpose of this policy is to define the process by which non-traditional missions are addressed. Any mission other than the flight to Washington D.C. or the Flightless Program is defined as non-traditional.

Article 2: History.

There have been occasions in the past when Villages Honor Flight was requested to provide an Honor Flight experience outside of the traditional trips to Washington or the Flightless Program. Examples have been an onsite virtual program for a large concentration of veterans, a group of incarcerated Veterans or at an assisted living facility. It has been determined that to host such an event required an excessive amount of work and volunteer hours.

Article 3: Approval Process.

Any non-traditional Honor Flight will be considered on an individual basis and will require Board of Directors approval.
