



**Villages Honor Flight, Inc.
Policy B-25
Mission Sponsorship Policy**

Article I – Purpose

To ensure Mission Sponsorship and naming of flights and VIP travelers is in accordance with Board of Director policy

Article II – Policy

In order to become a Mission Sponsor for a flight to Washington D.C., there must be a cumulative financial donation of \$25,000 (can occur more than once). This entitles the Sponsor to the following:

Naming of the flight – however, such naming must be for an individual (living or deceased) or charitable organization (not a business or personal cause), such name to be approved by the Board of Directors

A free trip for one VIP on the named flight

In order to become a Mission Sponsor for a Flightless flight, there must be significant ongoing service support for VHF, without compensation. The Mission Sponsor can be a Non- Villages Honor Flight individual or an organization (can only occur once and such Sponsor must be approved by the Hub President). This entitles the Sponsor to the following:

Use of the Sponsor name for the Flightless flight

Attendance and recognition of the sponsor at the Flightless flight
